The award ceremony will take place in Lagos, Nigeria on November 12, 2017.

M & M: Moreira Chonguica and Manu Dibango was launched on 31 March 2017 at the Cape Town International Jazz Festival.

All Africa Music Awards, AFRIMA, is designed to promote the distinct rich African music worldwide, engaging millions of fans by propelling African music to glorious pinnacles beyond the borders of Africa.

4,816 entries from African music professionals and music artistes were received at the close of a two-month entry submission window on July 17 this year. The nominations process has been described as rigorous and thorough, as the Jury of 13 resolve to be fair and transparent in line with the AFRIMA values of FACEIT (fairness, authenticity, creativity, excellence, integrity, transparency).
